The <u>PACIS Prize of Scientific Computing</u> (PPSC Plate) is intended to be the premier scientific computing prize in South America. The winner receives a modest monetary award, the PPSC award plate and becomes an honorary member of PACIS. The award is announced six days before the *Conference of Computational Interdisciplinary Sciences* (CCIS). The prize recognizes the academic contributions and exceptional achievement in the scientific computing areas as computational mathematics & statistics, computational physics and chemistry, computational biology and medicine. It was established by Panamerican Association of Computational Interdisciplinary Sciences in 2010. The winner is selected by a committee appointed by PACIS officers.
